Parking

You may have noticed the new road lines and signage outside of school, (the 30 mile an hour limit will be extended to Washpond Lane but is waiting to be authorised at County.) However, we are still getting cars parked on the zig zag and double yellow lines outside the school gate. This obviously raises significant safety concerns. Please help us keep our children safe. County have informed us of the following: the new lines are legally enforceable, and they are <u>no stopping.</u> So it is an offence to stop even <u>momentarily stop</u> on the lines if picking up a child or dropping off - photos of anyone parking on the school keep clear can be sent to Dorset police through their op snap initiative see below:
